




Reduction in the intensity of post-traumatic symptoms among patients



RAISING AWARENESS

In conjunction with the screening of the series "Valley of Tears" and in collaboration with Channel 11, NATAL initiated a strategic public awareness campaign targeting viewers of the series.

This TV series, about combat on the Northern front of the Yom Kippur War, contributed to an 88% increase in the amount of calls to NATAL's Helpline during the period that it aired. As many in Israel continue to suffer from post-traumatic stress, especially those who have served in combat, the series had the effect of triggering trauma symptoms such as flashbacks and anxiety.
